Acts 4:1-12



And as they were speaking to the people, the priests and the captain of the temple and the Sadducees came upon them, <sup>2</sup> greatly annoyed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead. <sup>3</sup> And they arrested them and put them in custody until the next day, for it was already evening. 4 But many of those who had heard the word believed, and the number of the men came to about five thousand.

# The CTS OF THE APOSTLES



- Luke and Acts started as one book encouraging Theophilus on the Life and works of Jesus.
- Jesus rises from the dead and reveals himself.
- Jesus **reveals his mission** and provides the power to accomplish it.
- His believers are filled with the Holy Spirit
- The life of Jesus and the fulfillment of the OT validates that God made Jesus Lord.



- The Jews face their reality of being enemies of God without Christ and ask what must they do.
- Peter tells them to "Repent!" and trust Jesus.
- God gives grace and many become Christians
- The early church begins to form Christian Community
- Jesus heals through Peter and John to validate his rule
