What Work Is

GENESIS 1:26-31: moves on the earth." ²⁹ And God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the earth, and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for food. ³⁰ And to every beast of the earth and to every bird of the heavens and to everything that creeps on the earth, everything that has the breath of life, I have given every green plant for food." And it was so. 31 And God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day.

God said...it is very good, the completion of his creation with man given charge over it.

Not much debate
Historical consensus on passage
Be: fruitful, multiply, subdue, have dominion

The complex interdependent enormous organism called earth needed shepherding and man was appointed that task

- B. Not originally toilsome
 - A. Holy and holistic by nature
 - B. Was in place before the Fall

Work Is Not

What happened? SIN...

- A. Brought infection
- B. Skewed original intention of the gift
 - A. Skewed our perception of work

Work Is Not

PSALM 127:1-2: Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain. ² It is in vain that you rise up early and go late to rest, eating the bread of anxious toil; for he gives to his beloved sleep.

Christ's redemption was overarching

- It covered every aspect
- Original gift returned opportunistically

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

COLOSSIANS 3:22-24: Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. ²³ Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

1 CORINTHIANS 10:31-33: 31 So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

EPHESIANS 6:5-9: Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, ⁶ not by the way of eyeservice, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, ⁷ rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, ⁸ knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. 9 Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

What did Jesus say was the greatest commandment?

Love God Love others as self

Redemption opens the believers' eyes and gives power to obey

Fulfill original mandate Good works (not apart from Christ or new creation realities)

Work wholeheartedly unto God, He rewards

Ultimately we are eternal minded, so our perspective is not catering to the World's view on vocation

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

NOT:

Get yours
You deserve better
They are not respecting you
Taking advantage of you
Wages are king
Education is king
Prestige is king

What Motivates our Vocation and the Choice of It

MATTHEW 6:30-34: But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? 31 Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' 32 For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. 33 But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. 34 "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

Or will we choose to dine on anxious bread?

Do you believe God actually sees all?

What Is Work's Purpose?

To honor God in fulfilling His purpose, His plan and the use of His gifts given to individuals

Man as Earth's shepherding
Plan is always redemptive
Man in His image bestowed with gifts and talents

What Is Work's Purpose?

Vocation is another language we use to tell the redemptive story

Why don't you fret, strive, claw?
Why do you honor, or work when no one else sees, or do
more than expected or trust even when seemingly
burned?

Why do you love your neighbor as yourself?
We obey in fulfilling NOT just His commands but in His
way by His power, We are now CAPABLE
Reward is not just a paycheck, but soul-ish fulfillment

What Is Work's Purpose?

To mold and shape us

Character
Image
Identity

What Is Work's Purpose?

NOT

Identity, rich or low...being careful about the ebb and flow with the winds of worldly instability.

To gain financial foothold of security

Stepping stone to "real" success

What Is Work's Purpose?

EPHESIANS 2:10: For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

His workmanship-fashioned, shaped, empowered to do good works, including vocation.

Actions speak louder
Are you telling the redemption story with righteous
attitude, passion, submission?

Are you giving fodder to unbelievers to blaspheme God?

What Is Work's Purpose?

Note how many parables, stories, and analogies are used in Proverbs, the Gospels, and letters to the Church that use work as a focal point/center piece.

Rebuking sluggards and laziness
Encouraging hard work
Wise financial, business, stewardship "counting the cost"
Chastening both workers and bosses alike
Arrogance and assumption of building bigger barns
Just or even scales
Bargain down a worthy purchase then brag about a great
deal

- Do I or will I in my vocation, regardless of circumstances, honor the Lord?
