For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns. <sup>7</sup> Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready; <sup>8</sup> it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure"—for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.

**Ephesians 4:25-27:** Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and **gave himself up for her,** <sup>26</sup> that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the **washing of water with the word,** <sup>27</sup> so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.

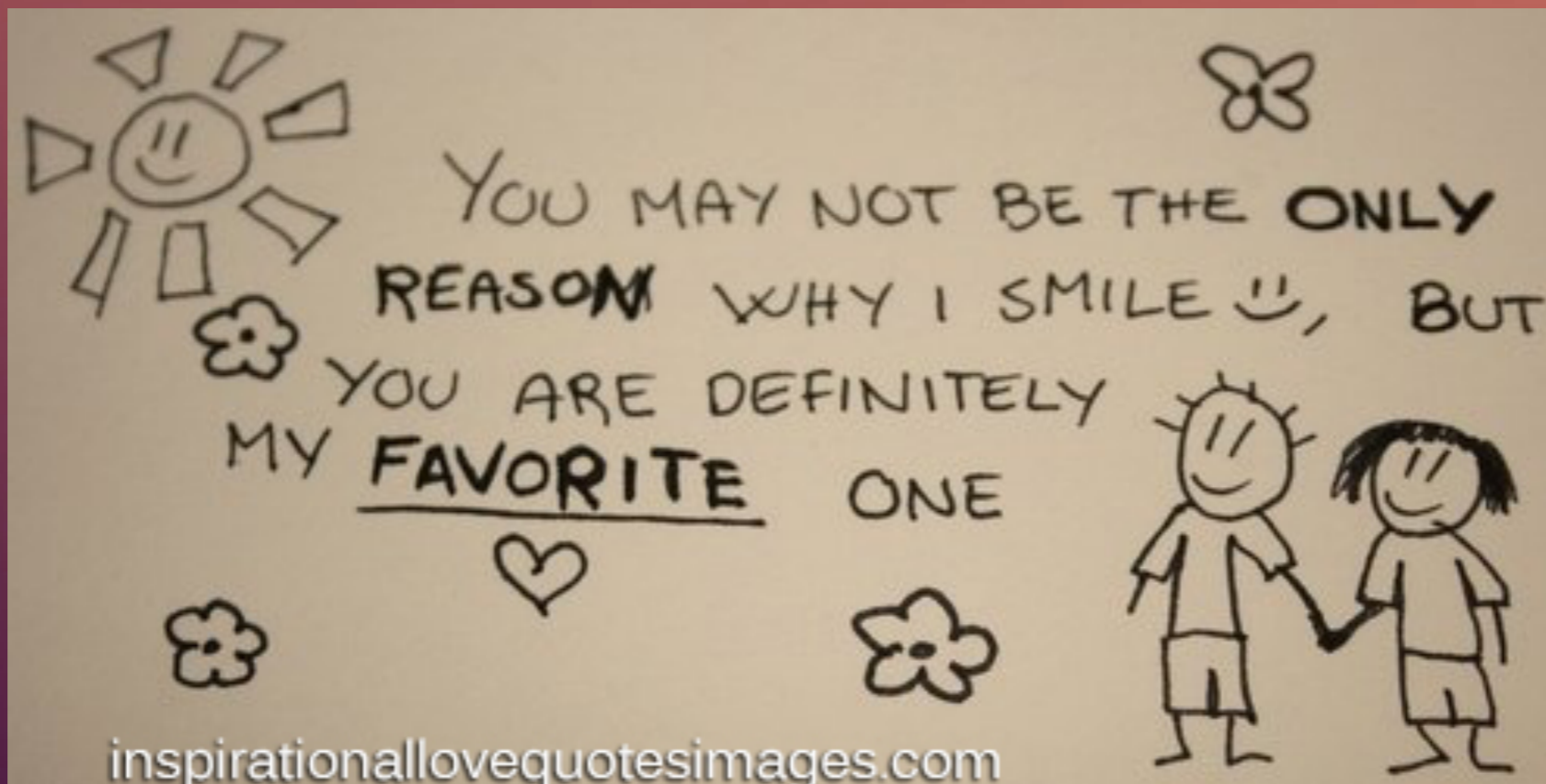
