
1 PETER 1:3-7.13


¹³ Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

UNFADING - EVERYTHING IS TEMPORARY

2 Corinthians 4:17 - an eternal weight of glory

Isaiah 2, 9, and 11 - kingdom of justice, righteousness, and peace forevermore
