Exodus 17:1

All the congregation of the people of Israel moved on from the wilderness of Sin by stages, according to the commandment of the LORD,

Exodus 17:1(cont.)-2

and camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink. 2 Therefore the people quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink."

Exodus 17:2(cont.)

And Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the LORD?"

**But the people thirsted there for water,
and the people grumbled against Moses
and said,**

**“Why did you bring us up out of Egypt,
to kill us and our children and our
livestock with thirst?”**

Exodus 17:4

So Moses cried to the LORD, "What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me."

Exodus 17:5

And the LORD said to Moses, "Pass on before the people, taking with you some of the elders of Israel,

Exodus 17:5(cont.)

**and take in your hand the staff with
which you struck the Nile, and go.**

Exodus 17:6

Behold, I will stand before you there on the rock at Horeb, and you shall strike the rock, and water shall come out of it, and the people will drink."

Exodus 17:6(cont.)

**And Moses did so, in the sight of the
elders of Israel.**

Exodus 17:7

**And he called the name of the place
Massah and Meribah, because of the
quarreling of the people of Israel,**

Exodus 17:7(cont.)

and because they tested the LORD by saying, "Is the LORD among us or not?"

Exodus 17:8

**Then Amalek came and fought with
Israel at Rephidim.**
