Romans 10:1

**Brothers and sisters, my heart's desire
and prayer to God for the Israelites is
that they may be saved.**

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:2

For I can testify about them that they are zealous for God, but their zeal is not based on knowledge.

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:3

Since they did not know the righteousness of God and sought to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness.

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:4

Christ is the culmination of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:9

Now for some time a man named Simon had practiced sorcery in the city and amazed all the people of Samaria.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:10

**and all the people, both high and low,
gave him their attention and
exclaimed, "This man is rightly called
the Great Power of God."**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:11

They followed him because he had amazed them for a long time with his sorcery.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:12

**But when they believed Philip as he
proclaimed the good news of the kingdom
of God and the name of Jesus Christ,**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:12cont.

they were baptized, both men and women.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:13

Simon himself believed and was baptized. And he followed Philip everywhere, astonished by the great signs and miracles he saw.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:14

When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to Samaria.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:15

When they arrived, they prayed for the new believers there that they might receive the Holy Spirit,

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:16

**because the Holy Spirit had not yet
come on any of them; they had simply
been baptized in the name of the Lord
Jesus.**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:17

Then Peter and John placed their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:18

When Simon saw that the Spirit was given at the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:19

and said, "Give me also this ability so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit."

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:20

**Peter answered: "May your money
perish with you, because you thought
you could buy the gift of God with
money!"**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:21

You have no part or share in this ministry, because your heart is not right before God.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:22

Repent of this wickedness and pray to the Lord in the hope that he may forgive you for having such a thought in your heart.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:23

**For I see that you are full of bitterness
and captive to sin."**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:24

Then Simon answered, "Pray to the Lord for me so that nothing you have said may happen to me."

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:25

After they had further proclaimed the word of the Lord and testified about Jesus, Peter and John returned to Jerusalem,

Acts 8:25cont.

**preaching the gospel in many
Samaritan villages.**

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:5

Moses writes this about the righteousness that is by the law: "The person who does these things will live by them."

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:6

But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down)

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:7

**"or 'Who will descend into the deep?' "
(that is, to bring Christ up from the
dead).**

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:8

But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the message concerning faith that we proclaim:

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:9

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:10

For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:11

**As Scripture says, "Anyone who believes
in him will never be put to shame."**

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:12

For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him,

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:13

**for, "Everyone who calls on the name of
the Lord will be saved."**

EVANGELISM



Jeremiah 31:33

“This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time,” declares the Lord...

EVANGELISM



Jeremiah 31:33cont.

"I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

EVANGELISM



2 Corinthians 3:3

You show that you are a letter from Christ,
the result of our ministry, written not with
ink but with the Spirit of the living God,

2 Corinthians 3:3cont.

**not on tablets of stone but on tablets of
human hearts.**

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:14

How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard?

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:14cont.

And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?

EVANGELISM



Romans 10:15

And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:26

**Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip,
"Go south to the road—the desert
road—that goes down from Jerusalem
to Gaza."**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:27

So he started out, and on his way he met an Ethiopian eunuch, an important official in charge of all the treasury of the Kandake

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:27cont.

(which means "queen of the Ethiopians"). This man had gone to Jerusalem to worship,

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:28-29

28and on his way home was sitting in his chariot reading the Book of Isaiah the prophet. 29The Spirit told Philip, "Go to that chariot and stay near it."

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:30

Then Philip ran up to the chariot and heard the man reading Isaiah the prophet. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:31

"How can I," he said, "unless someone explains it to me?" So he invited Philip to come up and sit with him.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:32

This is the passage of Scripture the eunuch was reading: "He was led like a sheep to the slaughter,

Acts 8:32cont.

**and as a lamb before its shearer is
silent, so he did not open his mouth.**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:33

In his humiliation he was deprived of justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth."

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:34

The eunuch asked Philip, "Tell me, please, who is the prophet talking about, himself or someone else?"

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:35

Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the good news about Jesus.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:36

As they traveled along the road, they came to some water and the eunuch said, "Look, here is water. What can stand in the way of my being baptized?"

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:38

**And he gave orders to stop the chariot.
Then both Philip and the eunuch went
down into the water and Philip baptized
him.**

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:39

When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way rejoicing.

EVANGELISM



Acts 8:40

Philip, however, appeared at Azotus and traveled about, preaching the gospel in all the towns until he reached Caesarea.
